### Downloading the Medicaid Exclusion File

This guide describes how to download and review the Medicaid Exclusion File.

The Medicaid Exclusion File lists covered entities that have chosen to use 340B drugs for their Medicaid patients (carve-in). The file also lists the Medicaid provider numbers and/or NPIs that the entities have identified as being used to bill for those drugs, to assist state Medicaid agencies in separating rebate-eligible claims from those that would result in duplicate discounts if rebates were requested. Entities must be consistent with their carve-in/out decisions: all drugs billed to Medicaid with a listed number/NPI must be purchased under the 340B program; entities that carve out must ensure that all drugs billed to Medicaid (under any provider number/NPI) were NOT purchased at 340B prices.

The 340B database takes a snapshot of carve-in decisions at 12:01am ET on the 15th day of the month prior to the start of each quarter, irrespective of weekends or holidays. Covered entities may submit online change request forms to modify their carve-in/out decisions at any time, but changes take effect quarterly and only then if approved by OPA prior to the snapshot for that quarter (e.g., a change submitted on June 1 and approved on June 2 will be reflected in the June 15 snapshot governing the July-September quarter; a change submitted on June 14 but not approved until June 16 will not be reflected in the June 15 snapshot and the prior decision will remain in effect until the quarter beginning October 1).

To download the Medicaid Exclusion File, follow these steps:

- 1) Click **Covered Entities** in the menu bar to see the **Download Medicaid Exclusion File** option and select, or click **Download Medicaid Exclusion File** in the **Covered Entities** section on the home page.

#### Download Medicaid Exclusion File

42 USC 256b(a)(5)(A)(i) prohibits duplicate discounts; that is, manufacturers are not required to provide a discounted 340B price and a Medicaid drug rebate for the same drug. Covered entities must have mechanisms in place to prevent duplicate discounts.

All covered entities that use 340B and bill Medicaid must determine whether they will use 340B drugs for their Medicaid patients (carve-in) or whether they will purchase drugs for their Medicaid patients through other mechanisms (carve-out). Covered entities that will carve-in are required to inform HRSA of their decision by providing their Medicaid provider number/NPI.

If covered entities decide to bill to Medicaid for drugs purchased under 340B with a given Medicaid provider number/NPI (carve-in), then ALL drugs billed to Medicaid with that number/NPI must be purchased under 340B and that number/NPI must be listed in the 340B program database. For covered entities that opt to purchase Medicaid drugs outside of the 340B Program (carve-out), ALL drugs billed under the applicable Medicaid provider number/NPI must be purchased outside the 340B Program and that Medicaid provider number/NPI should not be listed on the HRSA Medicaid Exclusion File.

The files available below allow drug manufacturers/wholesalers and state Medicaid agencies to identify organizations that have chosen to carve-in for a given calendar quarter. The 340B database takes a snapshot of carve-in/out decisions at 12:01am ET on the 15th day of the month prior to the start of each quarter, irrespective of weekends or holidays.

Covered entities may request changes to their decision at any time but changes take effect quarterly and only then if approved by OPA before the time of the snapshot. The files contain all entities that had at least one Medicaid provider number/NPI registered with OPA as of the snapshot for each quarter, along with program start and termination dates for those entities.


